Feminist Formations Anonymization Guide

Feminist Formations takes the anonymity of our blind review process seriously. Submissions that contain identifying information will be rejected.

- Identifying information should be in the Cover Page file ONLY.
- Nothing that could be used to identify the author should be included in the submitted manuscript, OR in the abstracts and keywords document.

Please be sure to follow all of the following instructions for anonymizing your manuscript:

- Do not identify your name as the author, your email, or your institution
- Check the document properties to be sure that it does not include identifying marks. (These often include author's name, email, or institution.)
- Anonymize any references to personal communications with named individuals with "[NAME REMOVED]."
- Anonymize acknowledgements and thanks with "[ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS REMOVED]."
- In MS word, open the file properties box and delete all identifying information
- Under the review tab, accept all changes
- If you cite yourself do so in the third person: Women write about oppression in schools... (Smith and Yee 2015), or
- redact: As in: "In my work on women and structural forms of oppression, I interviewed six families in New York in 1983, and 1996. (author) I also looked at schools in the area (author 2), and financial aid for colleges (author 3)," etc. You will have an opportunity to replace these citations if your manuscript is accepted for publication.
- Replace references to your work in the Works Cited/References list with (Author(s)) if citing in first person
